GUEST SPEAKERS

Vanessa Beasley, Ph.D. – Vice Provost for Academic Affairs and Dean of Residential Faculty

- "Residential College Overview"
 - Vanderbilt's Residential Colleges are on-campus residences in which the academic experience is integrated into residential life, creating communities and opportunities for learning outside the classroom among a diverse student body. They are led by faculty heads who live in residence and promote community building, faculty engagement, and connect Vanderbilt students with campus resources.
 - Concept of Residential Colleges for Vanderbilt began in 1999 with a committee focusing on three areas
 - 1. Enhancing faculty-student interactions
 - 2. Improving student retention
 - 3. Understanding and distinguishing the residential experience from the distance learning experience
 - Current Colleges include Ingram Commons, Warren and Moore Colleges, E. Bronson Ingram College, Zeppos College, Rothschild College is nearly complete, and Residential College C is under construction. In the 1950's the BOT made a 4year requirement for all students to live on campus. During this academic year – 1040 students are having to live off campus due to adequate space on campus for them. 25% of current upper division students live in a residential college during 2021-2022. The next area of focus for residential colleges will be Highland Quad.
 - All amenities in the colleges are open to all faculty and staff.
