


Approval of State Leaders by Party ID








Opinion of Gov. Elect Lee by Party ID










Approval of President Trump Over Time

Opinion on How Pres. Trump is Changing Washington Over Time








Views on Pres. Trump's Truthfulness Over Time

Overall, how much of the time do you think President Trump tells the truth?





Prefer legislators to work with out-party members



Preferences for Partisan Compromise by Party ID



Top 3 Priorities of TN State Government Over Time




Top Four Priorities For Tennessee State Government by Party ID








Feelings About Tennessee State Government Over Time











Support for Additional Vocational or Technical Education by Party ID




Views on School Vouchers - May-December 2018







Opinions on Medicaid Expansion by Income








Changes in Take Home Pay by Income




Do you think the opioid addiction in the state of Tennessee is a state of emergency, a major problem but not an emergency, a minor problem or not a problem at all?





Views on Opioid Addiction in Tennessee by Region



First Hand Knowledge of Person Affected by Opioids by Region



Do you approve or disapprove of making betting on sporting events legal in Tennessee?








Support for Border Security/Building of Walls by Party ID

Do you strongly favor, favor, oppose, or strongly oppose significantly expanding border security, including the construction of walls, along the U.S. Mexico border?






Opinions on Legal Immigration by Party ID

Would you say that people who move to the United States legally from other countries help the United States more than they hurt it, or hurt the United states more than they help it?






Views on Children of Undocumented Immigrants and In-State Tuition by Party ID








Views on Children of Undocumented Immigrants and In-State Tuition by Party ID – Over-Time








Views on Believability of News Media by Party ID

In general, how much of what you see, hear, or read, in the news media these days do you think you can believe?


