- 2. **Narrative**:Clearly <u>describe</u> everything you see, hear, smell, touch/feel, taste during your observation. Tell the story of your place with details and examples. Minimum: three paragraphs. Include all of #3-7.
- 3. **Science** Use either specific, common name (Barred owl) or **Vocabulary** scientific designation (Strix varia) for plant/animal.
- 4. **Patterns** Repeating or different behaviors of animals, plants, and or conditions over several entries. Or draw **Connections** connections based on your knowledge, observations, or speculations. This is like... because...
- 5. **Hypotheses** Suggest possible reasons for patterns. I think this and means that...
- 6. Questions: Ask questions that are intelligent and relevant.
- 7. **Examples**, **Data** <u>Details</u> of what you are seeing, hearing, smelling, and **Evidence**: feeling, tasting are listed and described in an entry.
- 8. **Writing** Spelling, grammar, punctuation, capitalization, and **conventions**: usage are correct. Writing is legible. Pages are numbered.

- 8. **Clarity**: All parts are complete, labeled, neat, and clearly drawn.
- 9. **Color**: Color, shading, and/or texture are included.
- 10. **Measurements** Actual size and counts of animals, plants, or objects and/or is stated. Accurate scale/map of whole place or
