Eight Things to Remember When You're Writing Lyrics

1. Make your lyrics conversational and natural
2. Be sure you put the emphasis on the proper syllable
3. Use words sound good sung
4. Simple lyrics are easier to remember
5. Simple lyrics are easier to learn
6. Simple lyrics force you to get to the point
7. When in doubt, say less
8. If you're using a metaphor in your lyric, stay consistent
