THE DOS

- Decide whether you're going to bring ideas to the session or start "cold"
- Show up on time and ready to work
- Make a plan on how you'll both promote the song once it's finished
- Discuss percentages for each co-writer

THE DONT'S

- Don't ever criticize a co-writer's suggestion
- Don't insist on one of your ideas if your co-writer isn't interested in it
- Don't edit too harshly early on in the session
- Don't push to collaborate with a more established/successful songwriter
