





#### 1783-1830: Independence and Disappointment

- 1. U.S. territorial expansion by default
- 2. Monroe Doctrine (1823)
  - a. American uniqueness
  - b. U.S. destined to expand
  - c. "exclude European influence from this hemisphere"
- 3. desire to penetrate Latin American markets
- 4. Monroe's two concepts:
  - a. noncolonization
  - b. two-spheres principle

### 1831-1897 Filibustering and Fury

- Mexican-American War (1846-1848) issue of Texas opposing forces and strategies
- 1. three-pronged United States offensive


Army of West - occupy New Mexico and California Army of Center - sent into northern Mexico Army of Occupation - carry fight to Mexico City

- 2. Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo
- 3. legacy: hostility, humiliation, xenophobia, civil wars

- 1. late 19<sup>th</sup> century American society and crisis in Cuba
- 2. coming of war
- 3. Dewey's naval victory in the Philippines
- 4. assault on Cuba: Teddy Roosevelt and Rough Riders Battle of San Juan Hill and heavy casualties
- 5. US naval blockade defeat of Spanish fleet
